INTENT

It is the desire of the MTAC to honor and assist graduating high school seniors in their pursuit of higher education the major of their choice; and to recognize those students of MTAC teachers who have demonstrated diligence and a conscientious commitment to the study of music.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have studied for a minimum of two years with a MTAC teacher including Junior and Senior year.
- Student must be a graduating high school senior. (Proof of college enrollment is needed to receive award.)
- Student must write and submit an essay of 75-100 words on the topic: "What I have Gained from the Study of Music". Please attach it to the application.
- Completion of the student application is required.
- **Postmarked application deadline** will be posted in the Branch Handbook. Mail to: Karon Potter, 4108 Windgate Drive, Denair, CA 95316.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Scholarships will be awarded based on a point system, which are accumulated by participating in the various events and activities as listed on the application.
- Scholarships will be awarded to students with the highest qualifying points overall.
- Recipients must show proof of college registration to claim the scholarship award.
- The number of scholarships given each year may vary, depending on the number of qualified applicants and the amount of scholarship funds available.
- The Memorial Scholarship recipient is ineligible to participate.
